## Prospectus for Ph.D. Programme – Session 2025-26

### **Introduction:**

The college was established in the year 1974 by (Late) Chandra Bhanu Gupta, a renowned social worker and a popular leader. Chandra Bhanu Gupta served as Chief Minister of the State for three terms. The college is running under the auspices of the Motilal Memorial Society. The objective of establishing the college was not merely to impart formal education but also to make the students better citizens by inculcating in them the virtues of self-discipline, self-confidence, social service and humility. **The college administration solicits co-operation from its discerning students and enlightened parents to fulfill these responsibilities.**

### **About the College:**

The National Post Graduate College is an autonomous college of Lucknow University with grade 'A' accreditation from NAAC. We work on the motto of '*Meritum Ethicus*' which means merit with ethics which aims at wholistic development of students and making them responsible global citizens. The college has adopted New Education Policy-2020. Necessary introduction of courses and modifications in the curriculum in tune with NEP-2020 have been implemented.

### **About the Program:**

For Ph.D. Entrance Exam, the paper pattern will be a combination of MCQ and descriptive questions. The Program **Course Work** will have **three papers** and will be for a total of **12 credits**. **Paper 1** will be **Research Methodology** worth 4 Credits, **Paper 2** will be conducted by each concerned department relating to their discipline, also worth 4 credits and **Paper 3** will be **Research Ethics and Language Proficiency** (depending upon the research interest of the student) which will be a common Paper worth 2 credits. The candidate shall also be required to **write one Seminar Paper/Research Paper** worth **2 credits** and endeavor to publish it in a Peer Reviewed Journal of repute. The classes for Course Work will be conducted both online and offline.

### **Note:**

1. If no candidate from the reserved category is found suitable for the reserved seat then that seat shall automatically be converted to General seat.
2. The Departmental Research Committee (DRC) shall have the power to declare (None Found Suitable) NFS in case the candidates do not meet the required eligibility criteria.

### **Eligibility:**

**Minimum 55 % marks in P.G. Programme**

(A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ Differently abled and other categories of candidates)

### **Admission Procedure:**

The candidates seeking Ph.D. admission in the college must read the prospectus carefully before filling the application form. Self-attested copies of the following documents must be attached:

- i. Marksheet of X and XII or equivalent examinations.
- ii. Marksheet of last examination passed.
- iii. Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution from where the candidate passed his/her last examination as a regular candidate (original certificate shall have to be submitted at the time of counseling).
- iv. Applicants who passed their last examination as private candidate should submit Character Certificate from the Superintendent of Police / District Magistrate / Gazetted Officer. The certificate should not have been issued more than six months before submission.
- v. Candidates seeking admission on reserved seats must attach attested copy of Caste Certificate. Candidates belonging to PwD category require CMO Certificate. Original Certificate must be produced at the time of counseling, failing which the candidate shall not be entitled to any reservation benefits.
- vii. Application forms completed in all respects along with copies of required documents will be accepted till the last date.
- viii. No admission form shall be entertained after the due date.
- ix. Incomplete application forms shall not be considered for admission.



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- x. Candidates qualifying in the entrance test will be required to appear before the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) for interview / counseling along with their respective Research Proposal for presentation where a tentative topic shall be decided.

## Note:

1. Candidates must submit their Character Certificate and Migration Certificate (In case the candidate is from a University other than Lucknow University) in original at the time of admission. An additional fee of Rs. 500/- shall be applicable on such candidates.
2. Candidates employed with state government or in any other establishment should produce No-Objection Certificate from their employer / competent authority for seeking admission in the College.
3. Any teachers seeking admission in Ph.D. (Teachers of Autonomous colleges, Government teachers, teachers of other Universities) need to bring NoC and their respective Appointment Letter at the time of Counselling. Teachers of any other aided/S.F. college need to produce VC approval letter and NoC at the time of Counselling.
4. For all Legal issues related to National P G College, appropriate courts of Lucknow shall have the jurisdiction.

## **Programme Fee Structure:**

**Annual Fee – Rs. 11,000/- [To be paid either online or offline at the college counter after declaration of final result.]\***

\*The fee is subject to revision from time to time.

## **Duration:**

According to the Research Ordinance of the College and in-keeping with the UGC norms the duration of Ph.D. shall be no less than 3 years and no more than 7 years. After 5 years a candidate shall be required to apply for extension stating appropriate reason and present before the DRC. No extension shall be given after 7 years barring special circumstances as prescribed by UGC.

## **Special Provision:**

All UGC, LU and College norms shall be applicable on women candidates seeking relaxation due to Maternity reasons and Child Care Leave (CCL).

## **Admission Prohibited:**

Following categories of candidates shall not be considered for admission in the College:

- i. Candidates having failed in a class cannot seek admission in the same class.
- ii. Candidates found guilty under IPC or their involvement in any kind of dispute, quarrel or anti-social activity anywhere, or misbehavior with the college staff or teacher shall not be considered for admission.
- iii. Candidates found guilty of using unfair means in the examination are also not eligible for admission in the college.
- iv. In case, a candidate succeeds in seeking admission by forgery / hiding facts, his/her admission shall stand cancelled on revelation of the facts.

## **Grave Offence:**

Following shall be considered grave offences and students found indulging in any of them would be severely punished:



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- Smoking & Chewing pan masala or betel leaf in the campus.
- Inviting any outsiders in the College campus.
- Misbehaving with teachers, college staff or fellow students.
- Ragging: Ragging has been declared a Criminal Offence by the Government.
- Encouraging students for violence or demonstrations.
- Carrying mobile phones anywhere on the Campus.**

## **Attendance and Examination:**

All Ph.D. programs offered by the College shall have regular classes for Course Work (Online and Offline mode). The progress of the students shall be monitored and evaluated by a continual assessment process. Regular attendance in the classes has its own importance and the responsibility of the candidate.
